- 1st Aid Certified Medic Needed Frontier District Cub Day Camp Medic Support Request; June 12th
 The Frontier District needs one more volunteer to serve as the on-site medic for their Cub Day Camp at 4 Mile
 Historic Park from 8AM to 12PM on June 12th. As the location is within 10 minutes of a 911 response team
 we only need a volunteer with current Basic 1st Aid / CPR / AED and YPT Certification. If you can help support
 the Frontier District on June 12th, please let us know.
- ESC Provided PV Fire Response Support
 - On Monday, March 3rd a fire occurred on the north edge of the McNeil Scout Ranch. The fire burned about 400 acres, mostly on the Malone Property to the north of camp. There was some encroachment East of Kiowa Creek, and towards the mesa. The fire line ran east to Sporting Clays Station 15. ESC supported Camp Staff using the ESC Incident Communications Protocol. ESC Team members were requested to monitor information websites, local news sources, and radio communications for information on the fire. New information and updates were consolidated and texted to council staff as necessary. This allows staff to deal with immediate matters on site while receiving updated specific information without spending time searching for it. This protocol has been used several times in the last few years and is very helpful to the Camp. If you would like to be a part of this team, please let us know.

ESC Projects in Progress

• McNeil Scout Ranch Ham Radio Repeater: The Scout Ranch Amateur Radio repeater is currently off-line due to a lightning strike that knocked out power. We are waiting for the weather to clear and the road to the Mesa to stabilize enough to get an electrician up to the wellhouse to make repairs. We are also waiting for good weather to pour a concrete pad to support the new Repeater box and gear installation.

Current Staffing Needs

• Training Program Lead and Training Topic Subject Matter Experts – We are looking for Subject Matter Experts to support Monthly Training. Each month has a different topic and we would like Scouters and other experts to lead discussions. A separate request regarding this effort will be coming out shortly. ESC Programs

Medic Program -

- Medic Call List: ESC maintains a Call list of volunteers with 1st Aid Medical training willing to staff Council
 and District events. Depending on the location, required medical training ranges from current Basic First
 Aid/CPR/AED certification to Paramedic. When an event is looking for Medic Support we send a notice to the
 call list looking for volunteers available and willing to staff. If interested in being added to the call list or

- Scouting Colorado Medic Protocols: ESC is working on a specific set of medic protocols to be used at Council and district events.
- **Medic Training:** The in-house training program provides 1st Aid / CPR / AED, Stop the Bleed Trauma1st Aid and Wilderness 1st Aid courses. The program is currently on hold with the exception of Stop the Bleed training as we restructure and find new volunteer instructors.



Radio Program - George Weber/ Greg Ostravich

- Ham License Testing Resources: Greg Ostravich is a licensing examiner and has shared resources and reference material for others to help gain their Technician, General and Extra licenses. This material can be found at: https://tinyurl.com/hamtesting
- Hamilton Scout Center and McNeil Scout Ranch Radio Shacks: A procedure to authorize Scouts and Scouters to operate the stations is available. Email Brad at <u>Johnston Brad@outlook.com</u> for more information.
- McNeil Scout Ranch Ham Radio Repeater: The KB0BSA repeater at camp (PV) is on 447.325 with a MINUS offset and a 151.4 Hz tone required. Provide audio (your call sign) and it will give a voice ID response in reply. Work is continuing on the new home for the repeater in the form of a Traffic Control box donated by the City of Parker and equipment donated by the ARES® of Douglas & Elbert Counties (R1D5). We are now waiting for good weather and availability of time to pour the concrete pad.
- Radio Library: The ESC/Radio Scouting team has many FRS Walkie-Talkie radios as well as some Amateur HF, VHF and UHF requiring Ham license available for check-out. FRS radios do not require any training or license to use. These radios are packaged into convenient carry boxes with instructions. The radios are available for all Scouting Units to check out. ESC Training Programs - We Need a Lead

ESC offers in-house training, coordinates training opportunities with both Scouting and outside agencies, keeps a reference list of available on-line training as well as passes on information about other training opportunities. Training is available for Scouts and Scouters. Courses vary in availability from in-person and teleconference, or on-line. To get information on upcoming ESC related training opportunities join the ESC Mailing List.

- **FEMA Incident Response Training:** Jeff Mosel has gathered a list of FEMA Free Study courses available on-line that train participants in Event Emergency Planning and Response. Everyone in the Greater Colorado Council planning or executing events (Camporees/Klondorees, NYLT Bighorn and Woodbadge trainings, Cub Scout Day Camps and other activities should review and consider taking the basic 4 classes. The classes list with more detailed training information for people responsible for specific roles is available on request.
- Community Emergency Response Team (CERT): We would like to initiate a training program to offer courses to Scouts, Scouters and the general public.
- **Training Curriculum:** We need to review the current list of training offered and the schedule. What works, what's popular, what's needed? Shall we do a survey?
- **ESC Website:** We have a new website in development at GCCESC.org. A significant amount of content is in process of being sorted and uploaded. Thanks Richard Hall.
- Safety Moments: Scouting USA asks that all Scouting Events include a Safety Moment at the beginning of each meeting, event or activity. ESC has a number of Safety Moment materials and training available.

Mobile Operations Projects - Brad

- Support Operations Trailer: We are waiting for warmer weather to begun 2nd stage renovation of the enclosed 4'x8' utility trailer to be used for evacuation and program support. In the event evacuation of the McNeil Scout Ranch is required this trailer will provide an initial Operations Base at the evacuation site to assist Administration (Check-In/Check-Out and Records Management), Cooking and cleaning (cooking gear, stoves and serving tables, cleaning and laundry equipment), Shelter with tarps, and Program activities with tables, tools and other supplies. Refurbishments and enhancements to the trailer and its equipment are in process.
- **PV Support Operations Storage:** A 20' shipping container has been set up at McNeil Scout Ranch to store camping gear available for use in an emergency or support to those at camp in need. The container needs to be surveyed and the gear available inventoried.
